

Three Warriors Named All-GLIAC

The Wayne State University men's basketball team received three Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference post season awards for the 2000-2001 season.

Sophomore forward **Brandon Gray (River Rouge, Mich.)** was named GLIAC South Division All-Defensive Team. Gray was eighth on the team in steals (9) and tied for second in blocks (7).

Junior guard **Mike Brown (Ann Arbor, Mich./Huron)** was named GLIAC South Division All-Conference Second Team. Brown led the Warriors in scoring (13.4 ppg.), assists (9.3), steals (4.7), three-point field goals made (5.9) and total rebounds (12.4).

Junior guard/forward **Reggie Kirkland (Detroit, Mich./Romulus)** was named GLIAC South Division All-Conference Second Team. Kirkland was third on the team in scoring (11.5 ppg.) and third in rebounding (4.6 ppg.). Kirkland led the Warriors in scoring five times this season.

Wayne State finished with a record of 12-14 overall this season. The Warriors were 9-4 at home this season and have a record of 35-6 the past three seasons at the Matthaehi Building.
