### This Week -

Wayne State (2-5-0) continues its schedule versus MAAC opponents as it hosts Fairfield University (1-2-0, 0-1-0) this Friday and Saturday, November 3 and 4. Both games will begin at 7:05 p.m. and are played at WSU's new "home" - Fraser Ice Arena.

### Last Games -

Wayne State went back on the road this past weekend and split the series at Iona losing 1-0 the first night, and then pulling out a 4-3 victory the second night.

On the Friday night loss, David Guerrero suffered his second loss of the season recording 29 saves. Iona scored its only goal of the game at the 19:47 mark in the second period.

On Saturday, sophomore Jason Durbin scored his first goal of the season in what turned out to be the game winner with 32 seconds remaining in the game. Daniel Rafner and Tyler Kindle both recorded two points in the win by scoring a goal and adding an assist. Goaltender Marc Carlson recorded his first win of the season with 17 saves.

For this season, four of five WSU's losses have been by one goal, including two overtime losses. The Warriors begin a three game homestand this weekend.

### Versus Fairfield -

This is the first meeting between the two teams.

### 2000-2001 Captains -

Sophomores Jason Durbin and Keith Stanich have been elected this year's team captains by their teammates. This is the second year in a row that Durbin has been named captain.

### Team Leaders -

Sophomore Daniel Rafner has jumped into the lead in scoring for the Warriors this past weekend. For the past three weeks, WSU team leaders have changed three times. Rafner currently leads with four points as he has two goals

and two assists. Sophomores Tyler Kindle, Brent Renfrew, Nick Shrader, Steve Nichols and freshman Chris Vail are tied for second with three points.

### **Head Coach Bill Wilkinson -**

Head Coach Bill Wilkinson begins his second year with the Warriors. Last season, he lead WSU in its inaugural season to a 6-23-1 record. This season he is 2-5-0.

Wilkinson is no stranger to the CCHA as he coached at Western Michigan for 17 seasons.

Wilkinson now posts a 321-329-54 record in 18 years of coaching (17 at WMU, 1 at WSU). He is also the chairman of the NCAA Men's Hockey championship selection committee.

Wilkinson is assisted by Danny Brooks, Willie Mitchell and Cal McGowan.

### **The CHA -**

College Hockey America (CHA) is in its second year of existence. Members include Air Force,

Alabama-Huntsville, Bemidji State, Findlay, Niagara and Wayne State.

Last season, Niagara won the CHA with a perfect 15-0 conference and a 29-7 overall record. Alabama-Huntsville was second with a 12-5 conference and 17-10 overall record, and Bemidji State was third with a 8-8 conference and 13-20 overall record. WSU was not eligible to compete for the conference title last season as the Warriors were an affiliate member only.

### **Next Up for the Warriors -**

The Warriors will remain home to host Findlay on Friday, November 10, and then play at Findlay on Saturday, November 11.

Wayne State returns home to host Air Force on Friday and Saturday, November 17 and 18.
