This Week -

Wayne State (4-5-0, 0-0-0) opens up conference play this weekend as it hosts the University of Findlay (2-1-0, 1-1-0 CHA) on Friday, November 10. The puck will be dropped at 7:05 p.m. at Fraser's Great Lakes Ice Arena.

The two teams will meet again on Saturday, November 11, as the Warriors travel to Findlay.

Last Games -

Wayne State is on a three game winning streak as it defeated Fairfield, 8-3, on Friday and 6-5 in overtime on Saturday.

On Friday, eight different Warriors scored a goal as they defeated Fairfield, 8-3. Sophomore Brent Renfrew had three points in the game as he scored one goal and added two assists. In goal, sophomore David Guerrero had 12 saves to record his second win of the season. WSU's eight goals are the most scored by the Warriors in the past two years.

On Saturday, sophomore Jason Durbin scored his third goal of the season with 43 seconds on the clock in overtime. It was Durbin's second goal of the game. In goal, sophomore Marc Carlson had 17 saves to post his second win of the season. Wayne State is now 1-2 in overtime games. Sophomore Marc St. Jean, after sitting out one year and seven games, saw his first collegiate start on Saturday versus Fairfield.

WSU Head Coach Bill Wilkinson was called out of town for this past weekend games, so credit the two wins to WSU assistant coaches, Danny Brooks, Willie Mitchell and Cal McGowan.

Redwood Named "ROTW" -

Jack Redwood, the 5-11, freshman from Trenton, MI, has been selected this week's College Hockey America "Rookie of the Week" for his play against Fairfield last weekend. In the two games versus the Stags, Redwood scored two goals and added one assist in the WSU sweep over Fairfield. This is the second time a Warrior has been named "ROTW" this season as freshman Jackson Wilson received the honor on October 23, 2000

Versus Findlay -

This is the fourth meeting between the two teams with Findlay leading the series 3-0. Last year, the Warriors won two of the three games (2-1 ot, 6-5) but had to forfeit the wins due to an ineligible player. Findlay defeated the Warriors 3-2 in the other game.

2000-2001 Captains -

Sophomores Jason Durbin and Keith Stanich have been elected this year's team captains by their teammates. This is the second year in a row that Durbin has been named captain.

Team Leaders -

The team lead has changed yet another time as now sophomore Brent Renfrew has seven points (four goals, three assists) to lead the Warriors. Tied for second in points are sophomores Daniel Rafner and Steve Nichols. Freshman Jack Redwood has jumped into third place on the team in scoring with five points and he's also the top scoring freshman.

Head Coach Bill Wilkinson -

Head Coach Bill Wilkinson begins his second year with the Warriors. Last season, he lead WSU in its inaugural season to a 6-23-1 record. This season he is 2-5-0.

Wilkinson is no stranger to the CCHA as he coached at Western Michigan for 17 seasons.

Wilkinson now posts a 323-329-54 record in 18

years of coaching (17 at WMU, 1 at WSU). He is also the chairman of the NCAA Men's Hockey championship selection committee.

Wilkinson is assisted by Danny Brooks, Willie Mitchell and Cal McGowan.

The CHA -

College Hockey America (CHA) is in its second year of existence. Members include Air Force, Alabama-Huntsville, Bemidji State, Findlay, Niagara and Wayne State.

Last season, Niagara won the CHA with a perfect 15-0 conference and a 29-7 overall record. Alabama-Huntsville was second with a 12-5 conference and 17-10 overall record, and Bemidji State was third with a 8-8 conference and 13-20 overall record. WSU was not eligible to compete for the conference title last season as the Warriors were an affiliate member only.

Next Up for the Warriors -

The Warriors will play at Findlay on Saturday, November 11.

Wayne State returns home to host Air Force on Friday and Saturday, November 17 and 18.
