Game Information

The Warriors begin the week travelling to Hillsdale for a GLIAC doubleheader against the Chargers. Hillsdale is 25-14 overall and 7-11 in the GLIAC. .

The Chargers are 10-3-1 at home this season. This is the first time in three seasons the Chargers have recorded 10 wins at home. As a team HC is hitting .259 with six homers and 121 RBI. Gretchen Messenger leads the team with a .355 batting average with two homers and 20 RBI. Freshman Joelle Frantz hit .400 last week with four runs scored. On the season Frantz is batting .256 with 10 RBI.

On the mound the Chargers have a 1.82 ERA in 257.2 innings. Junior pitcher Sarah DeAngelo is the ace of the staff at 13-6 with a 1.29 ERA. DeAngelo has 175 strikeouts on the season, which is a school record. She has the top three single-season strikeout totals in school history. DeAngelo is ranked 12th in strikeouts per seven innings and 16th in NCAA Division II in ERA. She has recorded double-digit strikeouts in seven games this season.

GLIAC Tournament

Following the Hillsdale doubleheader, the Warriors will host the 2001 GLIAC Softball Tournament in St. Clair Shores, Mich., May 4-5. The two-day tournament will be played at Kyte Monroe Complex. The double-elimination tournament starts Friday at 9 a.m. Scores from the tournament will be available on the Wayne State University Athletic website at www.wsuathletics.com.

Last Week

Wayne State was 5-1 last week, sweeping Lake Superior State, 3-2, 6-5 and Northwood, 6-4, 5-1. The Warriors split with Saginaw Valley, losing 2-0 while winning the second contest, 7-3.

Warrior Notes

- WSU was 5-1 last week batting .311 with 22 RBI. The Warriors had a slugging percentage of .401 with an on base percentage of .340.
- Junior **Kelly Kashmerick (Flushing, Mich.)** batted .550 (11-for-20) with two doubles, two triples and five RBI last week. She had 17 total bases for the week and struck out only once. She had a slugging percentage of .850 and an on-base percentage of .522. Kashmerick leads the Warriors in hitting with a .391 average. She also leads WSU in runs (36), doubles (14), triples (3), total bases (99), on-base percentage (.406) and sacrifice flies (2). Kashmerick has had 18 multiple-hit games and five multiple RBI games. She currently has a three-game hit streak. Kashmerick is batting .400 with runners on base and .415 with runners in scoring position. Kashmerick is tied for fourth on WSU's single-season list for hits (70)

- Freshman **Johanna Proulx (Brampton, Ont.)** hit .429 (6-for-14) for the week with one triple and a RBI. She is batting .274 on the season. She is hitting .360 when she is batting with two outs in an inning.
- Freshman **Beth Berry (Blissfield, Mich.)** added five RBI to her total last week (30). She needs 17 RBI to break the WSU single-season record. Berry is fifth on WSU's single-season list for home runs (6). She has 19 multiple-hit games this season and nine multiple-RBI games.
- Sophomore **Connie Milroth (St. Clair Shores, Mich./Lakeview)** was 4-0 this week with a 1.59 ERA. She has won four straight decisions and seven of her last eight games.
- Head Coach **Gary Bryce** has 645 victories in his 20-year WSU softball career. This is the 15th season in which the Warriors have won 30 or more games under direction.
