Coming Up -

The Warriors will return to ice on Saturday, December 2, when they host Findlay at 1 p.m. at the City Ice Arena in Detroit, MI. The two teams will face each other again the following day (December 3) at Findlay beginning at 2 p.m.

Last Games -

Wayne State lost two games at Mercyhurst. The Warriors lost the first game, 5-2, on Saturday, November 18, and then lost 6-0, on Sunday, November 19.

On Saturday, sophomore Amy Peters (Grosse Pointe, MI) scored at the 4:49 mark in the first period, but Mercyhurst answered back by scoring two goals of their own. Assisting on the Peters' goal was Joanie Denby and Katie Jones. Freshman Kelly Meech scored the other WSU goal with 1:42 left in the second period. Serena Hillman added the assist.

On Sunday, Mercyhurst came out strong by scoring four goals in the first period. The Lakers then ended the contest by scoring two more in the third period.

Versus Findlay -

This is the fourth meeting between the two teams as Findlay leads the series 3-0. Last year, the Oilers defeated the Warriors, 4-1, 11-1 and 9-0.

Conference Leaders-

Sophomore Amy Peters and freshman Kelly Meech and tied for 12th in point scoring with 1. Both are also tied for fifth in goal scoring with 1 and tied for fourth in power play points with 1.

Freshman goaltender Anna VanderMarliere (St. Clair Shores, MI) is third in the conference in goals against average (5.50), and save percentage (.872).

WSU Names Captain and Alternate -

Sophomore Kelly Pike has been named this year's team captain. Sophomores Serena Hillman and Amy Peters have been named alternate captains. This is the second year Peters has been named alternate.

Team Leaders -

For the third week in a row, freshmen Kim Spaulding (Farmington Hills, MI/Harrison) is leading the team in total points with six. Spaulding has two goals scored and four assists. Second on the team in points is sophomore Jamie Herod (Fraser, MI/Fraser) with five (two goals, three assists) and Katie Jones (one goal, four assists).

Head Coach Tom O'Malley -

Head Coach Tom O'Malley begins his second year with the Warriors. Last season, he led WSU in its inaugural season to a 0-21 record. Wayne

State owns the prestige as being the only NCAA Division I women's hockey program in the state of Michigan.

O'Malley now posts a 140-207-28 record in 16 years of coaching (15 at Boston College, 1 at WSU). O'Malley is assisted by Alain Frankiewicz.

Next Up for the Warriors -

The Warriors will play at Findlay on Sunday, December 3, at 2 p.m.

WSU will then be on the road playing at the University of Maine on December 7 and 9, before returning home to face Findlay on January 15 at 2 p.m.
